

Rain8net - Professional version of our RS232 sprinkler controller

- ON - OFF control of each valve at the Rain8 module itself, no need to run back to a PC to turn a zone on (or off).
- Each zone has a LED to indicate if it is running or idle.
- All valve wires and connections are protected against lightning surges.
- All RS232 and network connections protected against ESD and lightning.
- Each of the 8 outputs to the valves is protected against overloading by a self-resetting electronic fuse.
